2024-25 Mini-Grants Program

Is there a special project you've always wanted to do with your students?

Apply for a SEPTA (Special Education PTA) Mini-Grant and fund a creative endeavor that will enhance the education of students receiving special education services. Your successful project could be a model for other staff members, and positively impact student learning!

SEPTA Mini-Grants award up to \$500 to support any teacher or staff (OT, PT, SLP, etc.) who works with students with an IEP or 504.

The grants are awarded once a year for the current school year. Awardees may be asked to share their project with a blog post or meeting presentation. SEPTA may work with other entities to source funding.

Mini-Grant Examples

- Field trips (community engagement)
- Integrated play groups
- School improvement projects (garden, artwork)
- Resource materials (special books or materials for specific activities or projects)
- Materials for demonstration to school or district staff
- Professional development inservices will be considered especially if the training qualifies for recertification credit and can demonstrate impact on children
- Lego social skills materials

SEPTA mini-grants will not be awarded for:

- Parties
- General office supplies (paper, printer, toner)
